SCOPE AND SEQUENCE

Expanding Sound-Spelling Patterns

This set expands letter-sound knowledge by introducing common long-vowel spelling patterns, r-controlled vowels, vowel teams, diphthongs, and additional consonant patterns. Learners build flexibility as they recognize that sounds can be represented by different graphemes and that graphemes can represent more than one sound.

5. /aw/ Patterns and Diphthongs

au, aw, augh · oi, oy · ou, ow

6. Silent-Letter Digraphs

kn, gn, wr

This progression builds on the foundational correspondences introduced in Alpha-Code, Set 1 and supports increasingly flexible decoding and encoding as learners encounter more complex sound-spelling relationships.
